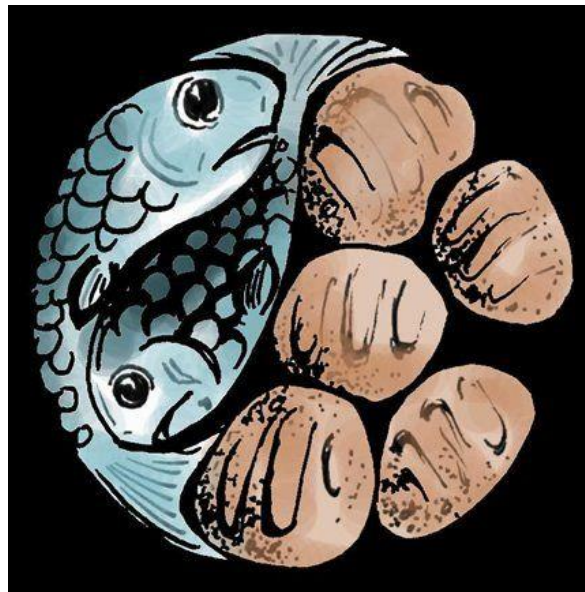
BIBLE READINGS
